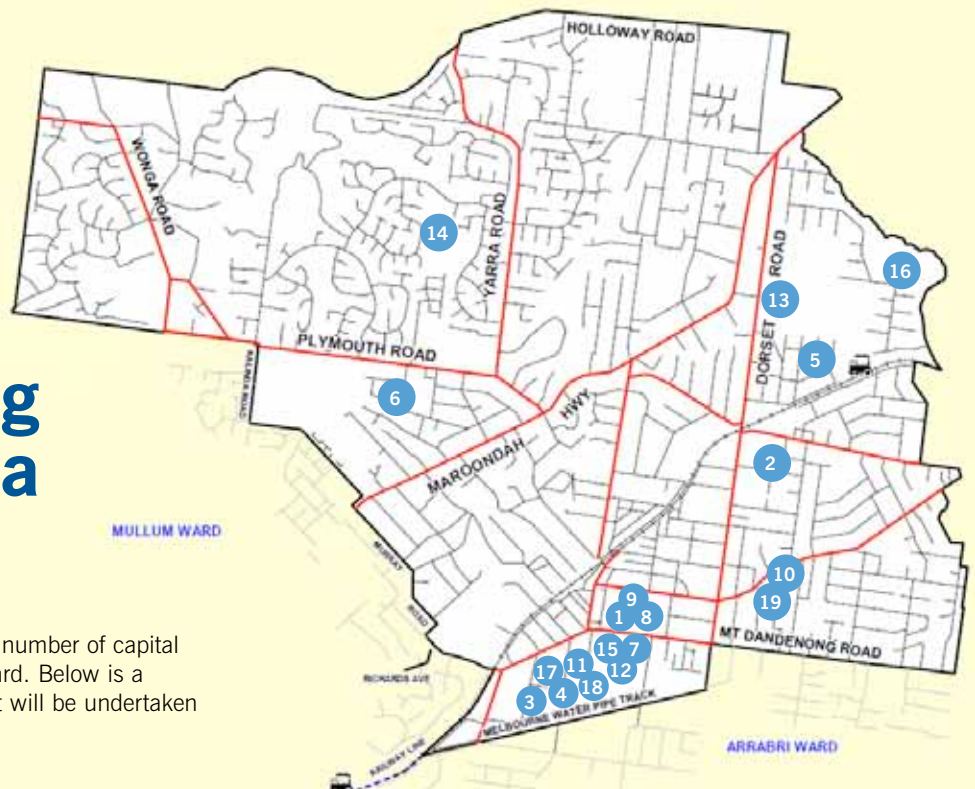


# What's coming up in Wyreena Ward?

In Council's 2016/17 Budget there are a number of capital works projects funded in the Wyreena Ward. Below is a sample of some of the major projects that will be undertaken this financial year.



- 1 Croydon Town Square redevelopment (\$1 million)
- 2 Lincoln Road reconstruction, stage 1 (\$1million from the Federal Government's Roads to Recovery funding)
- 3 Lusher Road drainage improvement works, stage 2 (\$600,000)
- 4 Aquahub roof renewal and update to heating and cooling systems (\$550,000)
- 5 Golf Links Road upgrade and drainage renewal works, final stage (\$500,000)
- 6 Lipscombe Park Kindergarten redevelopment (\$450,000)
- 7 Springfield Oval renovation (\$440,000)
- 8 Croydon Memorial Pool plant renewal (\$250,000)
- 9 Croydon Sporting Pavilion ground floor refurbishment (\$250,000)
- 10 Wyreena Community Arts Centre roof replacement (\$200,000)
- 11 Croydon Civic Precinct redevelopment masterplan design (\$100,000)
- 12 Croydon Town Park athletics lighting upgrade (\$100,000)
- 13 The Range/Dorset Road open space improvement works (\$100,000)
- 14 Yarrunga Reserve playground renewal works (\$100,000)
- 15 Springfield Sporting Pavilion redevelopment design (\$75,000)
- 16 Barngeong Reserve playground renewal works (\$70,000)
- 17 Croydon Bowls pavilion redevelopment design (\$50,000)
- 18 Croydon Town Park carpark development design (\$40,000)
- 19 Wyreena heritage masterplan design development (\$35,000)
