Projects up to \$7,700 100% Council Contribution

The application process:

- 1. Read the Capital Funding for Community Groups Guidelines and ensure you are eligible for funding
- Complete attached Capital Funding for Community Groups Project Proposal including all relevant supporting documentation and return to Sports and Recreation Project Officer -<u>heidi.grave@maroondah.vic.gov.au</u> - by **Sunday 23rd February 2025.**
- 3. The relevant Council Department/s will assess the Organisations Project Proposal and advise of any Council requirements for the project. Where applicable applications will be recommended via the Sports and Recreation Project Officer that they proceed to a full funding application
- 4. Successful applications The Organisation will be sent an invite to submit a full application. The application must have all supporting documentation attached along with a complete funding agreement (if applicable)
