

Please ensure you bring all your materials to <u>every class</u> and replenish as required

Basic Tools: Please ensure all tools are named

Note that you can purchase a basic tool kit from Walkers Ceramics for approx. \$17 that contains many of these items:

- Metal & Rubber Kidney Tools (for smoothing)
- Needle Tool
- General Turning Tool (for wheel work)
- Wooden Clean Up Tool
- Small Round Sponge (Yellow)
- Cutting Wire



Other items you will require:

- Craft knife / Potters knife approx. \$8
- Bag or Toolbox for Tools
- Note pad and pen/pencil for taking notes
- Apron
- Old towel
- BYO Mug for Coffee/Tea
- Brushes for glazing (optional later in term)

Clay: * Note that we fire Earthenware and Stoneware only.

Wheel Work – one block of wheel throwing clay, either fine earthenware or fine stoneware. For functional ware, tutor recommends stoneware clay: Walker PB 103 or Walker #10

Handbuilding – one block of handbuilding clay of your choice. Tutor recommends: Walker SES (School Earthenware Stoneware) approx. cost \$16 for 10kg bag

- * Note that the clay you buy will impact your glaze & underglaze choices, ie. Earthenware needs Earthenware glazes only and Stoneware needs Stoneware glazes.
- * Please bring clay to class each session and take home with you as there is no storage space for clay.

Glazes: Clear glaze is supplied by Wyreena. Coloured underglazes are to be purchased by students.

* Do not purchase glazes until advised by your tutor.

- * You can see glaze samples at Walker Ceramics and pick up a paper copy of their Underglaze colour ranges before you purchase these items. This will give you would have a good idea of what is available.
- * Note that the clay you buy will impact your glaze & underglaze choices, ie. Earthenware needs Earthenware glazes only and Stoneware needs Stoneware glazes.
- * New students may choose to purchase sample pots of underglazes from Walker Ceramics (Wunder Colour Kit - 7 x 20ml pots - approx. \$23.00 - A large range of colours to choose from.)

Kiln Firing: Bisque (1st Firing) \$8 per kilo / Gloss (2nd Firing) \$8 per kilo

* Kiln Firing fees are additional to the class fees and enable Wyreena to maintain and operate the kiln.

* Students will be required to pay kiln firing fees prior to the work being fired.
