

## Watercolour Painting

Wednesday 9:30am to 12:00pm and 12:30pm to 3:00pm - 2024

- **Paper:** Arches, Saunders or BaoHong 300GSM Medium (Most economical is to buy full sheets to cut down)
- **Board:** MDF or similar to support your paper (About 60cm x 40cm), and a roll of masking tape.
- **Watercolour Palette:** White plastic is fine, preferably with a lid.
- **Watercolour Paints:** They can get expensive so just buy the best quality you can afford. Preferably artist quality, and preferably in 5ml or 15ml tubes.  
The best brands are Holbein, Daniel Smith, M Graham or Winsor and Newton  
The **Winsor and Newton Cotman** set (20 tubes) is a good starter set and is available on Amazon (If you buy this set there is no need to buy any extra tubes)  
But if you want to buy individually here's a list of the colours I use:
  - Ultramarine Blue, Prussian Blue, Cerulean Blue
  - Turquoise Blue, Viridian, Moonglow (Blue Violet)
  - Raw Sienna or Yellow Ochre, Burnt Sienna, Burnt Umber, Cadmium Yellow
  - Alizarin or Deep Scarlett, Cadmium Red
  - Payne's grey, Lamp black
  - Chinese White
- **Brushes:** Once again buy the best you can afford.
  - Large round squirrel wash brush
  - Medium Flat brush (about 25mm wide)
  - Round synthetics (smaller and medium size)
  - Rigger brush.
- **Extras:** 2B Pencil, Eraser, Water Container x 2, Paper Towel Roll

***Prior to purchasing all materials, beginners may wish to discuss what they'd like to paint with the tutor in the first class.***
