## Please bring the following materials to every class:

- Art smock something to protect clothing such as an apron or an old business shirt
- A4 paper pad with thick paper at least 200gsm suitable for acrylic painting
- A4 visual diary
- Grey lead pencil pack (HB, 2B, 4B, 6B, 2H)
- Eraser
- Pencil Sharpener
- Black sharpie/marker pens (thick + thin)
- **Set of colouring pencils** (nothing fancy)
- Set of colouring pens/textas (nothing fancy)

- Paintbrushes 1 x small, 1 x medium, 1 x large. Preferably synthetic brushes (not hog hair as the hair falls out and doesn't hold water) in various sizes and shapes.
- Set of acrylic paints: Must include at least red, yellow, blue, black and white.
  A starter pack would be a good option (approx. \$15-\$30)
  Folder with plastic pockets for keeping artwork and worksheets
